

These Remain the SAME

While we are always looking for new things to grab your kid's attention and help them learn to know Jesus better, these following elements will always be a part of what we do in Ridge Kids.

- 1. **Activity Centers** As your child arrives we will strive to have activities available to help them engage and relate with one another and leaders. During this time kids are free to wander and are also served a small snack.
- 2. Offering We collect an offering every week in RK to help our kids learn how to give and that this is a part of our worship. Currently we were chosen by 2 boys who live in Cava, Mozambique and our offering is sent to World Vision every month to help provide for their needs. We encourage you to pray for Mussa and Raibo at home during your family dinner or devotional times. During April, we collected \$56.12 to send to World Vision for the support of these 2 boys. Thank you! Thank you!
- 3. **Communion—**We join the adult worship service and take the Lord's Supper on the first weekend of each month. There is always a short thought about what Communion means, a reminder of why we take it, and who should participate. While we don't require baptism, we do ask for kids who take communion to have a relationship with Jesus as their Forever Friend. Communion is not offered to Kindergarten & 1st graders unless requested by a parent or grandparent.
- 4. **Small Groups—**At the end of every service kids are divided into smaller groups by grades and genders. During this time we make sure kids understand the lesson and how to live it out in their homes and communities. Small group leaders have an opportunity to talk on a more personal level with kids and prayer requests are shared and prayed for. We ask for your patience as this is an extremely important time and we might ask you to wait an extra minute or two as we finish. Thank You!
